

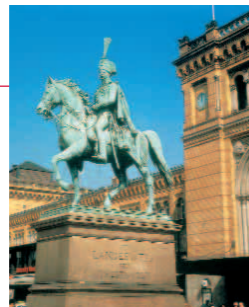

Hannover's Red Thread by Wheelchair



1 Hannover Tourist Information Centre

Lift for wheelchair users in the Sparda-Bank



2 Elegant 'Luise'

Ground level, disabled toilet on the first level of the underground car park

3 Opera House

Disabled access through a side door, wheelchair spaces and toilets

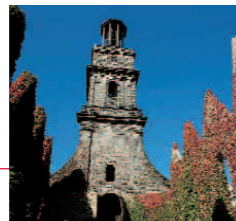


4 Georgstraße

Kerb ramps on every corner

5 Behind historic Façades

The Deutsche Bank cash machine in the 'Servicecenter' is easier to use. Access to the coin collection with the help of the porter



6 Around Aegidientor

Disabled toilet on the first underground level – the lift also goes to the platforms.

7 Aegidienkirche

Uneven paving but a ramp from the kerb, one step up into the church

8 Spartans' Stone

(see Aegidienkirche)

9 Art and History

KUBUS: lift (key with the porter)
'Volkshochschule' community college: disabled toilet in the basement. Please note – from here the Red Thread goes through a pedestrian tunnel. Turn left to the crossroads of Friedrichswall and Willy-Brandt-Allee



10 The Archer

On the Town Hall square – access only by steep ramp



11 Town Hall

Access to the right of the main entrance steps, no access to the viewing tower. Lift to the restaurant (outside ramp to the terrace), disabled toilets on the ground and first floors



12 Kestner Museum

Full access, disabled toilet

13 Coat of Arms Portico

Steps to the entrance

14 House of the Royal Master of Works

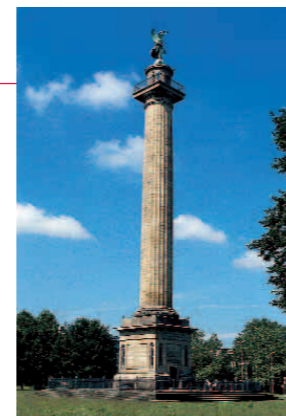
Steps only, no access

15 Wangenheim Palace

Steps only, no access

17 Waterworks and River Gods

Pedestrian tunnel with steep slopes; perhaps better to cross the road



18 Italianate Leine Bridge

No kerb ramps



19 On the High Bank

No access (steps); better to go to the Nanas (20), then across the next bridge to Beginenturm and on to Marstall Gate (21)

20 The Nanas

Uneven paving

22 Hannover's Oldest House

High kerbs, next ramp at Ballhof, ground-level entrance

24 Johann Duve Chapel

(see Kreuzkirche)

25 Ballhof

Wheelchair places and toilets available

26 Commoners and Kings – Museum of History

Key to the lift with the attendants on each floor, toilet



27 Leine Palace

Lower Saxony State Parliament
Entrance 100 m to the right in the car park, toilets



28 Monument to Leibniz

Uneven paving

29 In the Heart of the Old Town

Some restaurants and shops accessible, Disabled toilet at (30)

30 Hanoverian Gothic (The Market Church)

Ramps stored in the anteroom, best to give notice of your visit, disabled toilet on the marketplace

31 Old Town Hall

Ground level access from Karmarschstraße, Schmiedestraße and the marketplace, toilets in the basement, lift



32 Gargoyle

On the wall beside the portico (see Old Town Hall)

33 Market Hall

Two ground level entrances, disabled toilet on the ground floor, lift to the first floor

34 City Centre

Toilets in e.g. Karstadt Haupthaus, Galeria Kaufhof, Sinn & Leffers, Heutelbeck, C & A, Kaufhof (all on the fourth floor)
